1. Background

The Central Annamite Landscape (CAL), recognized as one of WWF's Global 200 Ecoregions and listed among Conservation International's biodiversity hotspots, contains one of the largest remaining tracts of intact tropical forest in mainland Southeast Asia.

Beyond their biodiversity value, the Central Annamite holds significant potential for climate mitigation, especially through REDD+ mechanisms that support forest protection and carbon finance. However, these ecosystems are under growing pressure from illegal logging, agricultural expansion, and infrastructure development. Increasing forest fragmentation-driven by land conversion and widespread monoculture plantations of acacia and rubber-has severely disrupted ecological connectivity, weakening the forest's ability to sustain locally driven community economy, biodiversity and ecosystem services. Biodiversity corridor spanning Hue, Danang, and Quang Tri provinces in Vietnam is a critical ecological zone that supports biodiversity conservation, climate resilience, and sustainable livelihoods. However, long-term financing for its protection and restoration remains a challenge. Long-term financing for sustainable investment within the landscape land use is also a challenge for large and medium size private sector. To ensure its sustainability, there is a need to assess existing and potential financing mechanisms and develop a viable financial model that aligns with conservation and community development goals. Mechanism that attracts sustainable investments from the private sector that benefit local economy and propose sustainable business/production models.

2. Objectives

The primary objective of this consultancy is to:

- Assess current financing mechanisms (public, private, blended, and innovative) applicable to landscape conservation in the target provinces.
- Identify gaps, opportunities, and risks in existing financing approaches.

 Propose the most suitable and sustainable financing model(s) for the biodiversity corridor, ensuring scalability and long-term impact.

3. Scope of Work

The Sustainable Financing Expert will:

- 1. Desk Review & Stakeholder Mapping
- Review existing financing mechanisms (e.g., government budgets, international donors, Payment for Ecosystem Services (PES), carbon credits, eco-tourism, green bonds, corporate partnerships, as well as contractual farming mechanism, including farmes,SME and commercial bank partnerthip, as well as GEF, GCF etc. The task will pay attention to the current policy and gaps analysis on policy at national and provincial level to support biodiversity led interventions. Beside the sources, also to pay attention to the recipients of the different financing systems.
- Identify key stakeholders/actors mapping (government agencies, NGOs, private sector, communities) involved in landscape financing.
- Particular attention on mapping of domestic finance for farmers and SMEs. E.g. specific financial products for farmers, and rural SMEs, from Agribank etc, and government-linked concessional lending.
- 2. Field Assessment & Consultations
- Conduct consultations with provincial authorities, conservation agencies, private investors, and local communities with focus on Hue, Da Nang, and Quang Tri provinces. The focus will be on WWF CAL interventions (from biodiversity to sustainable management and protection of forest and freshwater ecosystems, including inclusive conservation), and the consultant will engage each main projects team and prioritize the meetings with stakeholders.
- Assess willingness to pay, market-based opportunities, and challenges in implementing financing models.
- Assess accessibility to finance by local communities, smallholder farmers, SMEs, women, and marginalized groups in the target provinces.
- 3. Financial Mechanism Analysis
- Evaluate feasibility of financing mechanisms (that will such as:
 - o Public financing (e.g., provincial conservation funds, national programs).
 - Private-sector investments (e.g., sustainable forestry, agriculture, eco-tourism and Nature Base Solutions). Blended finance (e.g., donor-private partnerships).
 - o Innovative mechanisms (e.g., biodiversity offsets, green bonds, trust funds).
- Analyze legal/policy frameworks enabling or constraining financing options.
- 4. Recommendations & Roadmap
- Propose 2–3 sustainable financing models (covering conservation and production areas) with clear implementation pathways (from source to recipients)
- Particular map of domestic finance for farmers and SMEs
- Develop a roadmap for piloting/scaling the preferred model(s), including risk mitigation strategies. A roadmap for piloting/scaling should look at appropriate benefit sharing

mechanism(s) to identify clearly about the roles, rights, major responsibilities/authorities of stakeholders, private sector (SME) and local communities and assess landscape finance approach to inland, wetland and seascapes.

• Outline monitoring and evaluation frameworks for financial sustainability.
